



*The Voyage of the “Moonrise”

The yacht Moonrise completed a dream voyage of nearly 8000 miles that began in Seattle. Eileen and Don first sailed north to Glacier Bay, Alaska, then turning south, they cruised down the west coast of North America, Mexico, Guatemala, Costa Rica, Panama and through the Panama Canal to the San Blas Islands and Cartagena, Columbia. Then heading for Jamaica, Dominican Republic and east to Puerto Rico, St. Croix, then down the island chain as far as St. Martin where, at last, Moonrise headed northeast into the Atlantic and the long 2000-mile ocean passage to the Azores. Next landfall was Dingle, Ireland and an exploration of the east and west coasts of that beautiful island. And finally a North Sea passage from Falmouth, England to Hardejik, Holland.
