



The Voyage of the “Figment II” Catalina 320 Sailed by: Alec Blanc & Crew

Over a period of 3 years, Figment II and the skipper, Alec Blanc, sailed the stormy North Sea with crews from various UK companies and organizations. The purpose of these voyages was to offer a unique, teambuilding experience.

There were two passages from Ramsgate, England to Oslo, Norway and return—1300 miles each. One from Dover, England to Oslo and return—1300 miles, and one from Southampton to Oslo—1600 miles. Alec and crew also participated in the grueling, 605-mile Fastnet Race from Cowes to Plymouth via Fastnet Rock.

One crew faced 20 hours of the North Sea, force-eight gale winds and 20-foot seas. It was a new and exciting experience for them. They learned, first hand, the importance of depending on each other, the equipment and their boat.
